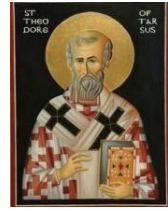


Lord Jesus, I believe You are really present in the Blessed Sacrament.
